Oct 18 th from 10:00 to 11:30 or from 13:00 to 14:30	Make and paint "Cho-chin lantern" together in Japanese traditional way. Cho-chin is Japanese paper lantern, developed in Kyoto in "Hei-an era" and still is popular in Japan, especially in Kyoto.	at "former Juraku elementary school" next to KIS
Dec 6 th from 10:00 to 11:30 or from 13:00 to 14:30	Making a picture flame with Urushi (known as "Japan") by polishing. The flame is originally painted with Urushi for several times, so by polishing the flame you can reveal the color inside and can make your original pattern.	at "former Juraku elementary school" next to KIS

Risk Assessment for (COVID-19) procedures

- All students MUST wear a mask.
- All students MUST submit a *Self Screening form** at the beginning
- All movement around and within the building is to happen within the 1-2 meter MEXT Guideline.
- Students are not to be in school if they show any symptoms of illness and must be symptom-free for 48 hours before returning
- Students are on campus only for the duration of the program.
- Students may not enter the building before their arrival time.
- Students will be allowed in the building at the assigned start time.
- Students enter the building without parents at their assigned entrance door.
- Students must wash and sanitize hands when entering the building.
- Students must adhere to the 1-2 meter MEXT Guideline rule when entering and exiting the building.
- Students bring only the minimal that is needed and take it all to the program:
- Parents are not allowed on campus except for that students can't stay alone.
